CHILD PRICE TICKETS FOR 11 TO 18 YEAR OLDS

Please note the following very important information for 11 to 18 year olds who travel on our Hertfordshire buses including those going to schools:-

11-18 year olds living in Hertfordshire

Following a change in arrangements with Hertfordshire County Council from 1st September 2018 11 to 18 year olds who at any time buy tickets from the driver will need to present a currently valid Hertfordshire Savercard in order to obtain child price single and return tickets. Without a Savercard only adult tickets (which are normally twice the price) will be available. Savercards are required to obtain child single and return fares on routes 306, 398 and B3 and school buses 303, 331, 346, 347, 358, 823, 833, B76 & B77

A Savercard costs £20 and will quickly pay for itself and may be used to obtain child price tickets on almost all buses in Hertfordshire. Visit www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/savercard to purchase and for more details.

Savercards are **not** needed for Sullivan Buses season tickets purchased online nor for children in school uniform purchasing weekly or 4-weekly tickets. However, for older children who do not wear school uniform; college students and purchases during school holidays a Savercard provides proof of age when purchasing weekly or four weekly tickets.

11-18 year olds living outside of Hertfordshire

Unfortunately Hertfordshire County Council do not allow 11 to 18 years old who are in education in Hertfordshire but live outside the county to purchase a Savercard. This would mean that from age 11 they have to pay adult fares on all buses in Hertfordshire.

Sullivan Buses have therefore decided to offer those aged 11 to 18 who live outside Hertfordshire, are being educated in the county and buy tickets from our bus drivers the opportunity to purchase a Child FareSaver Card that will give them child fares on all of our buses.

The Child FareSaver Card may be purchased for £20 (the same price as the Herts Savercard) from www.hertfordshireschoolservices.co.uk. The FareSaver Card is only available to 11 to 18 year olds living outside of Hertfordshire but being educated in the county. It is only available for use on Sullivan Buses routes 306, 398 and B3 and school buses 303, 331, 346, 347, 358, 823, 833, B76, B77. For most passengers the saving in fares will mean the cost of the FareSaver card is recovered after about 10 journeys.

Please note the Child FareSaver Card is **not** needed for Sullivan Buses season tickets purchased online nor for children in school uniform purchasing weekly or 4-weekly tickets. However, for older children who do not wear school uniform; college students and purchases during school holidays a Child FareSaver Card provides proof of age when purchasing weekly or four weekly tickets.
